<b>Full Load Information:</b>	60 credits per semester / 120 credits per year
<b>Smith College Deadline for Application to Host School/University:</b>	Fall Semester: April 1st, Spring Semester: September 1st
<b>Payments (Students must confirm with their host school/university that Smith is responsible for all tuition, room and board expenses)</b>	
Tuition Deposit Required?	No
Accommodation Deposit Covered by Smith?	Yes. The <a href="#">Study Abroad Coordinator</a> notifies Manchester of Smith students attending and deposit is then included in the invoicing to Smith.
Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent separately directly to Smith
Accommodation:	Invoice may be sent to Smith or directly to the student. Student must forward invoice on to the <a href="#">Study Abroad Coordinator</a> .
<b>Accommodation Expectations:</b>	Guaranteed, Students are required to apply for housing as soon as they are accepted into a program. Students should choose "mid-range" priced accommodation - not the most expensive and not the cheapest, but somewhere in between. In most cases, mid-range will be rooms in flats where you may or may not have your own bathroom (aka: en suite) and where you'll have to cook for yourself (aka: self-catered).
<b>Accommodation Application Deadline at University of Manchester:</b>	September 1st (due with Study Abroad Application Materials)
<b>Visa:</b>	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa.  It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
